

## **e-Piano Junior 2011: Preliminary Round Disklavier/Video Recording and Virtual Auditions**

Up to sixty (60) contestants, selected by the Artistic Director from the application CDs, will be invited to participate in the Disklavier/Video Recording. Seven sites around the world will be prepared for these auditions. The recording sites are in Toronto and Vancouver, Canada; Tokyo, Japan; Paris, France; Moscow, Russia; Los Angeles and New York City, U. S. A. If selected, you will be asked to attend the site nearest you at a specified time and date. Your performance will be recorded on the Yamaha Disklavier grand piano. The performance will also be videotaped. These materials will be viewed at the Virtual Auditions by the Screening Jury Panel in New York City.

### **Disklavier/Video Recording: (not to exceed 20 minutes)**

1. First Movement of a Classical Sonata (Beethoven, Clementi, Haydn or Mozart). Sonata from the Application CD can be used.
2. One Virtuoso Etude by one of the following composers: Bartok, Chopin, Kapustin, Ligeti, Liszt, Mendelssohn, Moszkowski, Prokofiev, Rachmaninoff, Scriabin or Stravinsky. Etude from the Application CD can be used.
3. Selection(s) from the Second Round Repertoire. **No other Repertoire is allowed.**  
**All repertoire must be performed from memory.**

### **Virtual Audition:**

A Jury, headed by the Artistic Director (non-voting), will be assembled for this audition. The performances will be reproduced on the Yamaha CFIIIS Disklavier concert grand piano and a large screen positioned on stage to hear and see each performance in its entirety. This Jury will select twenty-four (24) contestants who will be invited to come to the Minneapolis/St. Paul, Minnesota to participate in the e-Piano Junior Competition.

These twenty-four contestants who come to Minneapolis/St. Paul will be reimbursed for the cost of economy class roundtrip air fare to Minneapolis/St. Paul from the country of their residence, or from any city in the U.S.A. (up to 1000USD). The travel for the accompanying adult(s) will not be reimbursed. Those who choose not to come to Minnesota to compete will not receive any reimbursement. Accommodations and food will be provided to all 24 contestants and one accompanying adult per contestant throughout the duration of the competition.
